**The 1st or 2nd Place Winner may be invited to appear as a guest artist with the San Luis Chamber Orchestra at their concert on Sunday, May 19, 2019. Determination of eligibility and music will be considered based on selections chosen for the competition. The winner would perform one movement of a concerto, or a single movement composed for orchestra and solo instrument.**

No tie scores will be considered. Decision of the judges is final.

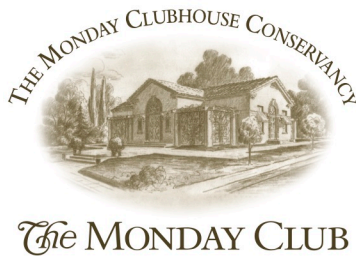
#### **ELIGIBILITY:**

1. Open to all junior and senior high school students residing in San Luis Obispo County.
2. The applicant may play any musical instrument found in a symphony orchestra or concert band. Piano is included.
3. Any vocal soloist is eligible.
4. NO recorded accompaniment is allowed.

The Music and Art Finalist Competition will be held at the Monday Club on **Sunday, March 24, 2019 beginning at 3:00 pm**. Finalists should arrive by 2:30 Pm and report to the Music Chair. Each student will perform a **classical piece and a contrasting selection**, as submitted with the application, to demonstrate the range of the student's ability. All music must be memorized and applicants must wear appropriate performance attire. Total presentation time for each applicant is limited to 15 minutes. The winners will be announced at the conclusion of judging Sunday, March 24, 2019. This event is free and open to the public, however donations to The Fine Arts Awards are greatly appreciated.

#### **SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS AND INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. Applications must be received by using the 2019 Fine Arts Awards Classical Music Competition Information found on The Monday Club website by **midnight, January 31, 2019**.
2. Auditions will be by digital submission. Once applications are received, each applicant will be sent a link to a Dropbox, where the submission must be uploaded by **midnight, February 3, 2019** to be considered for the competition.
3. Complete information is available on [“News & Information”](#) on The Monday Club website. Read all the information for “The Monday Clubhouse Conservancy Fine Arts Awards Competition 2019”.
4. **Click on the link provided** to access Registration for the 2019 Fine Arts Awards Classical Music Competition Application.
5. Read the information sheet carefully, complete the application online, and digitally sign to acknowledge understanding of all rules and expectations.



## PROCEDURE

1. Performances will be solo. An accompanist is required for instruments other than Piano. It is the student's responsibility to provide and arrange for his/her own accompanist.
2. Students will furnish their own instruments, other than the piano which The Monday Clubhouse Conservancy provides.
3. Upon request, a stipend of \$50 is available to finalists that need an accompanist.
4. Three impartial qualified judges will judge the applicants on tone quality, interpretation, intonation, phrasing, stage presence, dynamics, technique, accuracy and memorization.
5. Students will furnish three (3) copies of both music pieces for the judges.
6. The Music Chair will determine the order of student presentation. Students are expected to be present for the entire music competition.

**PRESENTATION & RECOGNITION LUNCHEON:** Attendance at the annual recognition of the winners is required and will take place during the regular luncheon meeting of The Monday Club, **Monday April 8, 2019 from 12 - 1:15 pm.** The student winners and their parents are guests of The Monday Clubhouse Conservancy for lunch. Each student will perform one of his/her winning selections on the occasion. No other piece may be performed.
