In 1962, under the leadership and vision of Alice Parks Nelson, the Monday Club Fine Arts Awards (art and music) were inaugurated and today we proudly continue this great tradition of supporting youth in our community with recognition and financial awards.

The mission of The Monday Clubhouse Conservancy is to preserve and restore the historic landmark known as The Monday Club of San Luis Obispo, and to provide public access to the landmark for educational purposes, and to carry on other charitable and educational activities. The Monday Clubhouse Conservancy is a 501(c)3 Public Benefit Charitable Foundation, Tax ID 95-1679667.

The Monday Club, listed on the National Register of Historic Places, was designed by Julia Morgan, the first-licensed woman architect in California and celebrated for her architectural creation of Hearst Castle.
